





Thirty students and four teachers were participated.











Two hundred and sixty six students and sixteen teachers were participated.






# WORLD DISABILITY DAY 2018 IN COLLABORATION WITH SPINE ORTHOSIS & PROSTHESIS MANJERI


#### INTERNATIONAL CLINICAL LABORATORY WEEK 2019






#### PERFUSION WEEK 2019

Ninety-five students and ten teachers actively participated in this initiative.



#### WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2019



Two hundred and forty students and eighteen teachers were participated.










#### OPTOMETRY CAMP 2019

Twenty nine students and three teachers were participated.




#### PHYSIOTHERAPY CAMP 2019

Thirty students and nine teachers were participated.










#### WORLD AIDS DAY 2019

World AIDS Day is a crucial opportunity to acknowledge the essential role that communities play in the AIDS response at the international, national, and local levels.


























#### AWARNESS CLASS AT BLIND OLD AGE HOME KEEZHUPARAMBA 2019


#### WORLD HEALTH DAY 2021






#### INTERNATIONAL CLINICAL LABORATORY WEEK 2021

















#### HYPERTENSION DAY -2021








#### MEDICAL CAMP 2021






#### OPTOMETRY CAMP 2021




#### WORLD DIABETES DAY 2021

















#### **OPTOMETRY CAMP 2021**




#### CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION 2021






#### WORLD OPTOMETRY DAY 2022






#### HEAMOPHILIA DAY 2022



























## INTERNATIONAL PHYSIOTHERPY DAY 2022


#### WORLD HEART DAY 2022




### OPTOMETRY CAMP 2022 AT RAMANATTUKARA MUNICIPALITY

















## WORLD AIDS DAY 2022















#### **OPTOMETRY CAMP- 2023**




#### WORLD HEALTH DAY 2023


## MEDICAL CAMP 2023
