




ACADEMIC PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT
















ADMINISTRATION

FINANCE AND ACCOUNTS

Tally ERP is used for finance and accounts management, providing a comprehensive solution for daily transactions, purchase management, and account keeping.

STUDENT ADMISSION & SUPPORTS

The admission process for Allied Health Sciences is conducted through Lal Bahadur Shastri (LBS) Centre for Science & Technology and the Self Financing Paramedical Management Association (SPMA). The post-admission process is managed through "Campus Medicine", the academic software.

EXAMINATIONS
